

From Our Pastor

In 2016 we saw our vision of life to the fullest in Jesus lived out. We celebrated **50** baptisms this year! That means 50 people now not only understand what it means to know God but took tangible, faith-filled steps to center their lives on Him.

We experienced our greatest Sunday morning attendance growth in five years. These are individuals and families who've found PAC to be a welcoming community where they can grow, serve and belong. The fastest growing group is young adults, the future of the church. Our cumulative growth took us past the boundaries of two services to the launch of a third. We've fully engaged **87** new servant-leaders to help make that third service possible. Another **327** are taking steps to find their just-right fit in ministry at PAC. They're experiencing how bringing hope to others is a higher purpose worth living out.

We welcomed our largest crowds ever while hosting Summer Blast events in partnership with Plainsboro Township. And we broke our record for Christmas Eve attendance. But far more important than numbers, we continue to see how special it is to serve a diverse church family. And how God is actively using that diversity to expand His kingdom.

I'm grateful to serve with a Governing Board that guides and protects the church, and a staff that sacrificially leads the congregation. But none of this could be possible without *you* listening and responding to God as you follow Him, love each other, pray, and reach those who don't yet know Him.

On Mission

PAC exists to help you live life to the fullest in Jesus. We do this by knowing God, developing community and bringing hope. This is our vision and mission.

Know God

- We celebrated **78** adults, teens and children choosing to follow Jesus.
- We baptized **50** Christ followers.
- We shared the Gospel with **464** children at PAC Summer Camp where **10%** decided to follow Jesus through the help of **208** volunteers.

Develop Community

- We completed **2** more sermon series with PAC-produced small group curriculum: The third and final installment of our HOPE series, "Hope Unleashed," and our Hebrews study, "Like No Other."
- We offered **90** small groups with **1,211** adults, teens and children participating.
- We welcomed **17** adults into membership.
- We partnered with Plainsboro Township to celebrate community through **3** Summer Blast events in our local parks.

Bring Hope

- We sent **222** adults, teens and children to mission fields stateside and overseas on **14** different teams.
- We provided **16** cars to local families in need and reestablished our motel ministry to the homeless.
- We fed families in need through more than **39,000** donations to The Pantry, eggs from **15** local chickens, and bread donations from Panera.
- We've helped **414** individuals engage in finding a place to serve God and His Church through our new weSERVE volunteer development initiative.
- Four restrooms received over **\$67,200** in upgrades and roof repairs were made above the leaky main lobby.
