Know God

- Read through the entire Word of God
Read all 66 books of the Bible without skipping or skimming. Visit princetonalliance.org/resources, select Study Plans, and choose from nearly 70 different reading plans in multiple languages.
- Sacrifice your money for a specific purpose
With a joyful heart, sacrificially give toward ministry at PAC or elsewhere. Pick something that you can connect with, something that resonates with you, and support it.

Develop Community

- Commit your life to a multiplying community
Don't go it alone. Get involved in a [small group](#). Invest in the lives of others and allow them to invest in yours.
- Look for and pray for new relationships
Watch for God at work. Keep your heart and your eyes open for opportunities to establish new friendships and share Jesus. When opportunities arise (and they will), take them.

Bring Hope

- Pray for the entire world
Pray for those around the world who need to know Jesus including those in the countries where PAC has strategic ministry partnerships: Mexico, Brazil, Thailand and New Zealand. You can start small with Operation World's [60-Day Prayer Experience](#), praying for 60 countries in 60 days. From there, use the [Prayer Calendar](#) to pray for a country a day.
- Spend time in another context
Whether locally or globally, step out of your comfort zone and serve God by serving people who aren't like you. Go on a PAC mission trip or become involved in local outreach...but be bold enough to do it in an unfamiliar context or culture.
