Pray that:


- people would commit to Christ and His transforming power

Our first church plant, began weekly services on February 21, 2010.
Here's what God did through this new body of believers in 2010:

- Provided over 1,000 meals to people in need
- Delivered over 200 gifts to children this Christmas
- Gave over \$330,000 in weekly offerings
- Gave over \$70,000 to open the new youth center
- Baptized 26 people into a relationship with Jesus
- Formed 12 small groups with over 130 people
- Averaged 238 people in attendance each weekend
- First Blueprint Class with 65 people committed to "own the mission"

REGIONAL

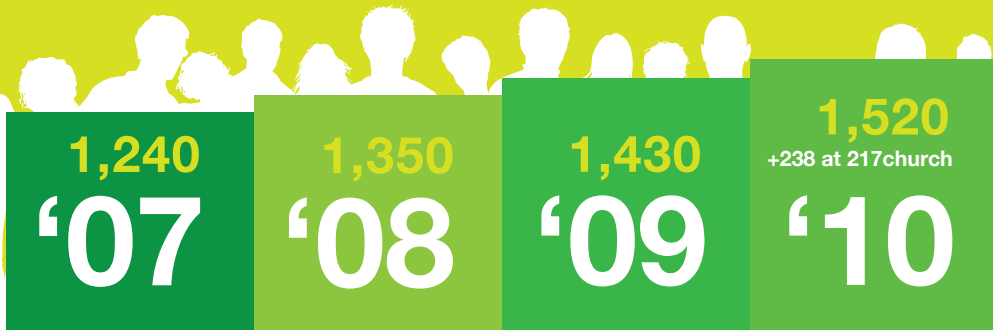
- We partnered with Living Hope Church - Trenton, NJ

Weekly giving is vital to Princeton Alliance Church.

Through the generosity of God's people we can fulfill the vision and mission that he has specifically called us to. General Fund giving covers critical ministries of the church including Children's Ministries, Adult Ministries, Student Ministries, Communications and Celebration Arts and the maintenance our facility. A few milestones from 2010 provide insight into how these funds are used:

- We remodeled the sanctuary with no fund drive and no debt.
Why? To be able to get more people in!
- We invest in people through training and spiritual coaching.
Why? Because discipleship is both inward & outward focused.
- We redesigned our web as an outreach and marketing tool.
Why? To reach more people through princetonalliance.org.
- We opened a new community outreach called Movie in the Park.
Why? To make connections with families in the community!
- We hosted 700 kids in our week-long summer camp experience.
Why? So the kids in our community don't miss out on Jesus!

The sum of our work is to ensure that we as a church honor Jesus in a way that stewards all the resources that he has given us (money, equipment, property, staff).
